What is respite?

Respite is taking a break from the daily challenges of caring for a loved one who has intellectual and/or developmental disabilities.

Personal Support Workers

Direct Support Professionals assist individuals in their home and community outings all based upon an individual's wants and needs.
2 hours/session minimum | \$9 co-pay/hour

In-Home Services

One-on-one service provided by certified Direct Support Professional in an individual's home.
2 hours/session minimum | \$6 co-pay/hour

Group Respite

Monthly respite nights hosted at the HUB from 5pm - 9pm for individuals aged 5 and up
\$20 co-pay | 2:1 staff ratio | Dinner provided

Social Opportunities

Quarterly trips for small groups, including transportation, meal, and admission fee (if applicable)
Fee varies per activity | Trained staff
